




In Guanajuato live great stories! Get to know this place of the Bajio that has it all.

The State of Guanajuato is engraved in the hearts of its visitors, with its modern Mexicanity of its cities, its colorful streets and alleys, its beautiful mountains, moors and valleys that give it a warm, relaxed and friendly character.


Guanajuato is perfect in any season with its mild climate and rich land. Agricultural and cattle ranches have made it prosper since the Colony, which today welcome us in their ancient haciendas full of legends and stories.



The City of Guanajuato, natural setting for the International Cervantino Festival and San Miguel de Allende, named Best City in the World, are both recognized as Cultural Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO; as is the Camino Real de Tierra Adentro, the commercial route that for centuries communicated towns and mining activities from the center to the north of New Spain.

In addition to its historical heritage and rich cultural and sports offer, the State of Guanajuato invites you to visit its great cities: the extensive strawberry fields that surround Irapuato, the museum dedicated to the renowned Chavez Morado brothers in Silao, the special neoclassical parish in San Jose Iturbide, the baroque altarpieces of the Temple of San Agustín in Salamanca, the distinguished architecture of Francisco Eduardo Tresguerras in Celaya with its cajeta factories and the great city of Leon capital of footwear and the leather industry with activities for all tastes.

Guanajuato is gastronomy, adventure, romance, architecture, history, business and culture. It is where the greatest stories of the country take place and the ideal setting to live your own history.







#### LOCATION

- It is located in the central part of Mexico, south of the Mexican Altiplano. The state surface is part of the Sierra Madre Oriental, Mesa del Centro and the Neovolcanic line.
- It borders to the north with the states of Zacatecas and San Luis Potosí, to the south with Michoacan, to the east with Queretaro and to the west with Jalisco.
- Its average height above sea level is 2,015 meters.

#### **TERRITORY**

- It represents 1.6% of the national territory, this is 30,589 square kilometers.
- It occupies the 22nd place in territorial extension.
- The dry and semi-dry climate predominates in the northern region; warm sub-humid in the southwest and east, and in the rest of the territory there is a sub-humid climate.
- The highest average temperature is around 30  $^{\circ}$  C (May to June) and the lowest, around 5.2  $^{\circ}$  C (January). The average annual temperature is 18  $^{\circ}$  C.
- The rains occur in summer, mainly between the months of June and September.

#### **HYDROGRAPHY**

The state is touched by the water system of the Lerma-Chapala-Santiago and by the river system of Panuco-Tamesi. The Lerma River pours its waters into the Pacific Ocean and the Pánuco into the Gulf of Mexico.

#### **VEGETATION**

The most abundant plants in the state are encino, mesquite, nopal, palm, palo dulce, fern, maguey, pitahaya, pirul, joconoxtle, tronadora, estafiate, white sapote, biznaga, ash, garambullo, ahuehuete, huisache, pepahuaje and casahuate.

#### WILDLIFE

Mammals of the region are rabbit, fox, squirrel, deer, coyote, armadillo, opossum, American lion, hare, skunk, wildcat and ounce. There are also birds such as buzzard, owl, hawk, thrush, quail, pheasant, chachalaca, hawk, owl, woodpecker, hummingbird, raven, huilota, cenzontle, torcaza, wall jump, aura and magpie.

#### PROTECTED NATURAL AREAS

It has 25 protected natural areas, including: Cubilete Hill, Temascatio River Basin, La Joya Lake-Crater, Yuriria, lagoon Las Fuentes, Las Musas, Megapark Bicentenario, Metropolitan Park, La Purisima Dam, volcanic region of Siete Luminaries, Lobos, Penjamo and Gorda Mountains.


#### INDIGENOUS LANGUAGES

The most widely spoken languages are Otomi, Chichimeca Jonaz, Nahuatl and Mazahua. In Guanajuato there are more than 14,000 people over the age of five who speak an indigenous language.

#### **AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITY**

Agriculture is developed in 48% of the state surface. The main crops include corn, chickpeas, beans, barley, wheat and peanuts.

# WINETRAIL

The priest Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla knew about the fertility of the soil of Guanajuato, for this reason, from the beginning of the 19th century he planted vines and taught the residents of the town of Cocoman - today Dolores Hidalgo - how to make wine. After the independence, this noble activity was lost and 200 years later, it returned from the hand of a new generation of wine-growing houses, filling the landscapes of the state with grape vines.

The five routes can be followed according to the town one is in, offering the opportunity to get to know the Guanajuato terroir, walk through the vineyards and learn about the processes that transform grapes into wine and taste different labels.

We will include the FIGLeón International Globe Festival experience, an event that Leonese people have lived for 18 years, this festival has been listed as one of the three best of its kind worldwide and the only one in Latin America. The experience of admiring more than 200 balloons in the air has made it one of the most anticipated and visited events around the world.

We want to tell your love story, with an unforgettable experience! by flying in an anchored hot air balloon, where everyone can enjoy a spectacular view of the city and take incredible photos with your friends and family, you will also taste the authentic and traditional Leonese snack in a night picnic.

Enjoy an authentic Leon picnic with a traditional menu:

- Guacamayas: It is a tradition for Leonese people to eat a bread roll stuffed with hard pork or pork rinds, accompanied by pickled skin, spicy tomato sauce with lemon and salt.
- Caldo de Oso: Preparation that contains vinegar of pineapple, lemon, chopped onion, salt, chili, which can be piquín "the one that stings" or "the one that does not sting" and salted grated cheese. La Bomba is prepared the same way with chopped fruit cut into small cubes, it can be jicama, cucumber, pineapple and mango.
- Cebadina: Refreshing, digestive and natural traditional drink prepared with barley, tamarind pulp, hibiscus syrup and water without sugar, you will add sodium bicarbonate when you are ready to drink it and should take it immediately so it does not spill.
- Craft beer from the State.
- Mezcal & artisan wine from the State.
- Cheese and cold cuts from the State
- Tumbagones.

Flight Restrictions: Children over 5 years, maximum weight per passenger 90 Kilograms, minimum height to climb is 1.10 meters, people with heart problems, hypertensive, pregnant, with recent injuries or surgeries cannot climb.

To fly the hot air balloon, a calm wind is required, no greater than 9-10 km / h.

Former Hacienda Ibarrilla

The magical and imposing hacienda was built between the years 1540 and 1600, belonging to the Silver Trail or Camino del Virreinato. Years of history are enclosed in its perfectly preserved walls, as well as in its small, handcrafted tunnels built in the time of the Cristeros.

It is a unique place, with only two haciendas of the same type currently preserved in all of Mexico.

It has different spaces from gardens to a "former textile factory" built in 1800 which was adapted to hold events, creating unique stories.

Within this majestic venue you will find the perfect spaces for your event, such as "The sleeper bar" with capacity for 30 people, ideal for wine tastings and small events. With a calm and bohemian air framed by the semi-desert environment, Mineral de Pozos was not always abandoned, since at first various nomadic indigenous groups such as the Chichimecas, Huachichiles, Copuces, Guaxabanes and Pames found in these lands the perfect place to set up their camps. Little did they know that at their feet, there were streaks of gold and silver.

## MINERAL DE POZOS





By the eighteenth century in the colonial era's boom, the town that originally focused on agricultural activities was founded. However, with the discovery of the Santa Brígida mine, the fate of the town was sealed for mining activities. Its population were dedicated to the search for gold, silver, copper and zinc during the Porfiriato, until its residents abandoned it in 1920.

Now, which is only the echo of those mining times, the town has come to life in another way. Travelers come to it to enjoy the solitude that prevails in the environment but above all to walk through its cobbled streets, the vestiges of the haciendas and mining sites. In the afternoons they visit antique and handicraft stores to buy some quartz or semi-precious stones from the local mines. Reminiscence of the past that this magical town reveals.

It is possible to get to Mineral de Pozos from the cities of San Juan del Rio in Queretaro, Guanajuato and San Luis Potosi. The best season to visit this destination is from February to December, as you will enjoy a warm semi-desert climate.
